He was born in Rotherhithe, South London to Maurice Micklewhite, a Catholic fish-porter, and Ellen Maria, a Protestant charlady. He grew up in nearby Camberwell and, during World War II, was evacuated to Norfolk. When he first became an actor he used the stage name "Michael Scott".
